The following rules, regulations and fees have been approved by the Eagles Mere Fire Company effective Jan. 1, 2017.

Use of the Community Hall

1. **Any person or parties** who wish to use the community hall must secure permission from the appointed rental agent.

- 2. The Fire Company retains the right to refuse rental to any party that they feel would not be in the best interest of the Fire Company.
- 3. The Company Hall must be cleaned immediately after use or the Fire Company will have it cleaned at a rate of \$25 per hour (\$50 minimum) if not cleaned to the satisfaction of the rental agent.
- 4. Tables and chairs must not be removed from the building
- 5. Rates are established for daily basis. Anyone wishing to use the facilities for longer periods of time may enter into an extended agreement with the approval of the appointed rental agent and/or the House Committee.
- 6. Rates for the Community Hall are \$450 for any individual or for-profit groups.
- 7. The following organizations may use the Community Hall at a reduced fee, \$100 during summer, \$150 per day during heating season November 1-May 1, but must make reservations with the rental agent. There will be cleaning charges imposed if not cleaned to the rental agent's standards.

 - c. Eagles Mere Association and EMAA

 - e. Eagles Mere Sewer Authority

- 8. Any other organizations or individuals not listed above may use the Community Hall at the discretion of the Housing Committee for reduced rate or no charge.

 - b. Local Funerals

Notice:

The Community Hall is the property of the Eagles Mere Fire Company. Any and all items left at the Community Hall will become the property of the Eagles Mere Fire Company and may be disposed of at their discretion.

Rules for Community Hall

Effective January 1, 2017

Due to rising fuel and maintenance cost, all parties who were rent free will be charged \$100 per day during summer months, \$150 per day during hearing season-November 1-May 1.

Any individual or party using the Community Hall must reserve the Community Hall by calling Brian Smith, prior to usage. Anyone using the Community Hall without prior arrangements will be treated as trespassers and may lose privileges to the Community Hall in the future.
